

## **Bob Daniel Summary**

I am running for the Board to continue to represent the issues of Mission Hills and Uptown's six neighborhoods, and to vote how my neighbor stakeholders would vote.

I have been a 35-year Mission Hills resident currently on Bandini Street, and previously on Kite Street, since 1983 and am a strong advocate for the six Uptown districts as well as Mission Hills and its Western Slopes neighborhood. It's important for our neighborhoods to continue to have local representation on the Uptown Planners community advisory group since its sphere encompasses several neighborhoods. There are a lot of issues and decisions that are being reviewed by the City and it's important to have a neighborhood representative to make sure any changes will benefit us.

I have served as a Board Member on Uptown Planners for 4 years, and am a Board member of the Metro San Diego Community Development Corporation. I am also a founding member and currently the Acting Chair of the Western Slopes Community Association. WSCA has been instrumental in getting a Study funded for the extension of the railroad "No Horn" or "Quiet Zone" from Sassafras Street to Old Town. This has taken nearly 4 years, has been co-funded by the City and County, is in procurement now, and is scheduled to be completed in early fall. I continue to monitor this closely, since less train noise would benefit many Mission Hills and Middletown residents.
