Board Meeting & Election – March 6, 2018  
FINAL MINUTES

Meeting called to order by Leo Wilson at 6:01.

In attendance: Jay Newington, Jennifer Pesqueira, Gary Bonner, Bill Ellig, Amie Hayes, Ken Tablang, Tim Gahagan, Mat Wahlstrom, Michael Brennan, Leo Wilson, Soheil Nakhshab, Stuart McGraw. Board members Tom Mullaney and Bob Daniel also in attendance; but because they were candidates abstained from participating in the board's supervision of the election.

Upon the meeting being called to order, the board election commenced. There were four candidates running for three seats. Each of the four candidates running was provided time to speak to those in attendance at the meeting. The four candidates were:

- 1.) Bob Daniel, Mission Hills
- 2.) Clint Daniels, Mission Hills
- 3.) Tom Mullaney, Mission Hills
- 4.) William L. Smith, Jr., University Heights

The Election Committee which conducted and supervised the election consisted of Gary Bonner, chair, Stuart McGraw and Michael Prinz. In addition, board members Aimee Hayes, Soheil Nakhshab, Michael Brennan, and Brittany Bailey from the Third District City Council Office, participated in conducting the election. The voting ended at 7:30 p.m., and the Election Committee counted the ballots.

A total of 168 individuals voted; the votes for each candidate were:

William Smith, Jr.	131 votes
Tom Mullaney	120 votes
Bob Daniel	118 votes
Clint Daniels	52 votes

William Smith, Jr., Tom Mullaney and Bob Daniel obtained the most votes, and were elected. Their four year terms will begin at the April 3, 2018 meeting.

Uptown Planners Board Meeting:

The regular board meeting began at 7:30 p.m. Wahlstrom made a motion to approve the agenda, which was approved by unanimous voice vote.

At public comment, Kathy Keehan of the San Diego Air Pollution Board gave an update on the work of her organization. Zack Bunshaft, representing Congress Member Susan Davis office, reported on the congress member's activities.

There were no agenda items. The Election Committee presented the results of the election, which were read at the meeting. The board ratified the election results, and the meeting was adjourned at about 8:30 p.m.
