Does the reward money come from tax dollars?

Yes, presently the reward money comes from tax dollars. However, in all cases the City will require the graffiti vandal to reimburse the City for the reward money.

Will I be notified if my claim is rejected?

Yes, you will be notified by mail if your claim is rejected.

Can I call to report graffiti even if I don't see the crime in progress?

Yes. You can call the 24 hour graffiti hotline at **(619) 525-8522**. Remember, rewards are only for information which leads to the arrest and conviction of graffiti vandals.

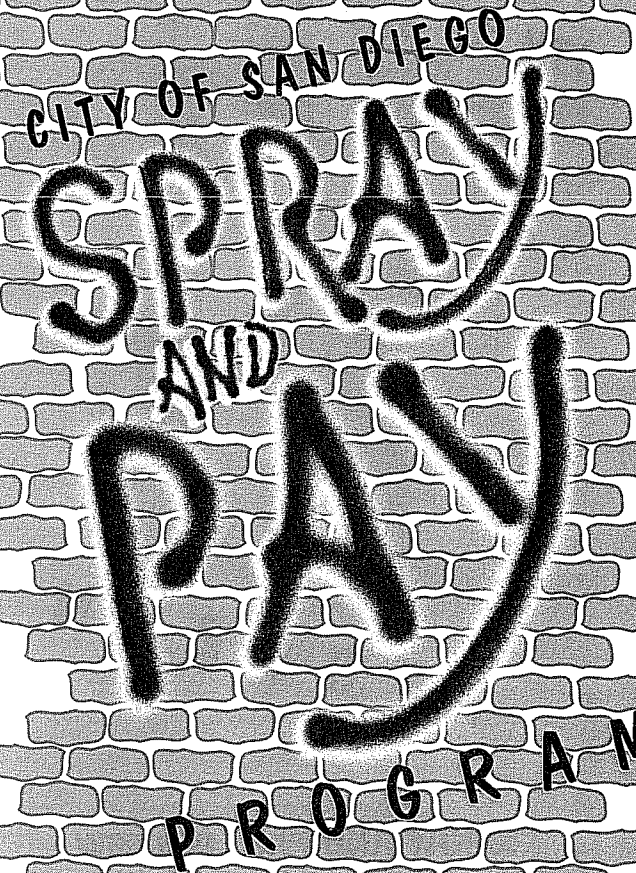

CITY OF SAN DIEGO SPRAY AND PAY PROGRAM

"SPRAY AND PAY" is a new program created by the City of San Diego to pay a reward of up to FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) for information which leads to the arrest and conviction of graffiti vandals.

How the Program Works

If I do witness a crime of graffiti in progress, or if I have information regarding a crime of graffiti, who should I call?

Vandalism is a crime. If you see a graffiti crime **in progress**, call **9-1-1**.

Do I have to disclose my name to be eligible for an award?

Yes, you must disclose your name in order to be eligible for a reward. You cannot remain anonymous if you wish to collect a reward.

How do I obtain a claim form?

A claim form may be obtained at all City of San Diego Neighborhood Service Centers and Police Storefronts. You may also call the **Graffiti Control Program** at **(619) 525-8522** to have a claim form mailed to you.

When do I receive my reward?

You will receive the reward after the suspect is convicted. In some cases, it may take up to a year from the date of the incident before you receive your reward.

Is the amount of the reward always five hundred dollars (\$500)?

No, the award amount is **up to** five hundred dollars (\$500).

How does the City decide the amount of reward I will receive?

The amount of reward will be decided on a case by case basis and may take into consideration the amount of property damage involved.

If I report an incident in which there are several suspects, can I receive up to five hundred dollars (\$500) for each suspect that is convicted?

No, the maximum reward you may receive is five hundred dollars (\$500) per incident reported.

What if more than one person files a claim for a single graffiti incident?

The City may divide the award among the claimants depending on the facts in each case.
